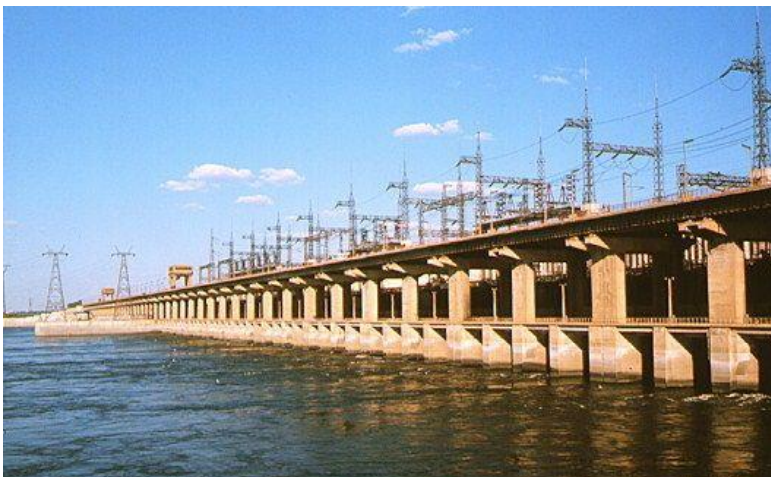


SPILL OVER HYDRO ELECTRIC DAM VOLGA - RUSSIA

The **Volga Hydroelectric Station** or Volga GES also known as the **Stalingrad/Volgograd Hydroelectric Power Station**, is the largest hydroelectric station in Europe and is the last of the Volga-Kama Cascade of dams, before the Volga River flows into the Caspian Sea.



In 2011 maintenance began on flow regulating valves of the spill over.
After cleaning and roughening of the surface, **ZINGA** was applied by spraying with a layer thickness of 100 μm DFT.



System:
Surface preparation: blasting
SA 2,5 and Rz 50-70 μm
ZINGA 1 x 100 μm DFT
